Cancellation Policy:

Registration fees will not be refunded after October 14 (late registration deadline) except for an official travel advisory by the Highway Patrol.

Medical Releases:

A medical release is required of anyone under 18 years of age. A signed copy (form provided) must be sent in with the registration before the conference. A copy should be kept with your group for travel.

Sponsors:

Sponsors must be 21 or older. and a ratio of 1 sponsor to 7 girls is required.

Sponsor Forms:

Sponsor forms are provided with the registration form. Churches must approve those attending as sponsors and sponsor forms must be signed by someone from the church other than the sponsor or spouse of the sponsor. The form is required on all adults attending.
