

Cost for Mother-Daughter and GA Retreats

October 3 & 4

Registration Fee: \$30 per person

(Postmarked by September 3)

Late Registration Fee: \$35 per person

(Postmarked by September 10)

Fee includes: program, one night's lodging, and two meals—Saturday breakfast and lunch.

Medical Releases

A medical release is required of anyone under 18 years of age. A signed copy (form provided) must be sent in with the registration before the retreat. These are required even if the girl's mother attends. A copy for traveling purposes should be kept with your group.

Refund and Cancellation Policies

Registration cost will not be refunded after September 10 (late registration deadline) except for an official travel advisory by the Highway Patrol.

Sponsors

If a mother is unable to attend, her daughter may come with a sponsor. Sponsors must be 21 or older and a ratio of 1 sponsor to 7 girls is required.

Sponsor Forms

Sponsor forms are provided with the registration form. Churches must approve those attending as sponsors and sponsor forms must be signed by someone from the church other than the sponsor or spouse of the sponsor. The form is required on all adults attending, including mothers.

Special Needs

Please indicate all special needs on the registration form. These could include physical, medical, food allergies, etc.

The retreats begin with worship at 7:30 PM on Friday. Plan to arrive early to check-in. Both retreats end Saturday at 4 PM.

Recognition Service

This service is to recognize girls who have finished a level of WorldVentures (a wMu GA program in the local church) in the last year but have not been recognized on the state level. Please record information on the Registration Form. Girls should bring dressier clothes for the Recognition Service.



Things to Bring

Bible, Pen, Paper, Umbrella, Soap, Shampoo, and other Toiletries, Bedding (including pillow, sleeping bag, or blanket and sheets), Towels, Washcloths, Warm Jacket, Casual Clothes (jeans/slacks), Flashlight, Alarm Clock. There will be a bookstore and pop and snacks available for sale.

Ministry Project

Each girl should bring decorations for a pair of flip flops. They will decorate flip flops to be donated to girls in Iowa. Supplies could include ribbon, yarn, beads, jewels, fabric, hot glue gun, etc.



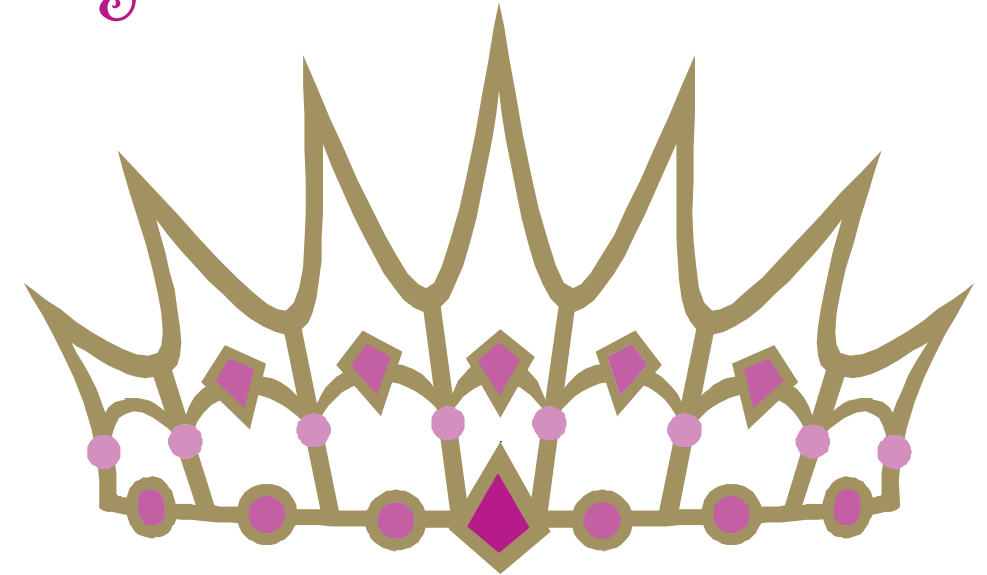
