Things to Bring:

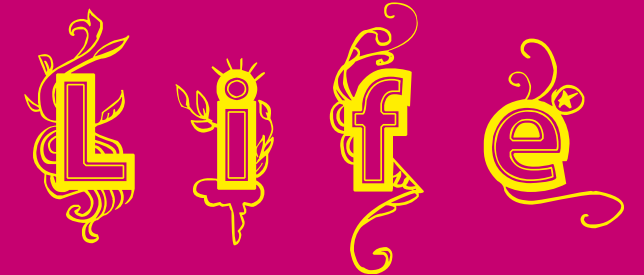
