- Age-graded, Bible-teaching classes that study the same Scripture passage
- A simple, informal Worship Assembly designed to reinforce the application of the common Bible lesson
- A very intentional, well-focused, lay-led ministry

- It places high priority on relationships with Christ and with one another
- It provides intimate care and accountability in small groups
- It provides for all ages
- It is organized to reach people
